Born in Israel, Roy had your average upbringing... if you count the confusion of his roots, family elements, eventually winning the "little fella" lottery, a series of injuries, a minor law enforcement altercation, both abroad (Netherlands, UK, El Salvador) and on U.S. soil (multiple military bases and standard spots), and deciding to raise him in Kentucky. Pursuing the profession of Stand-up Comedy was only inevitable.

Whether it's making fun of his height (he's a shorty, y'all—5'2"), tackling personal issues, slamming an analytical magnifying glass on world events and society in general, or sharing a story from his travels – Roy's comedy is live, direct, and playfully honest. Though he often leads his audience down a dark, twisted road, they willingly follow because they know there is a light at the end of the tunnel.
